
Did you hear about the pick pocket that only stole candy bars? He has a few Twix up his sleeve.

I don't like reading a horror story in brail. Something bad will happen. I can feel it.


I friend grew an entire foot the summer after his 8th Grade. It took 3 surgeries to remove.
